Am 7,12-15

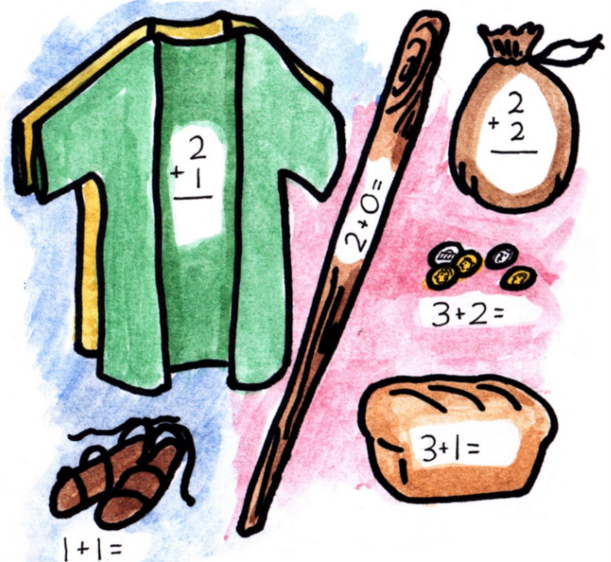
